NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING THE JAMAICA BAY WATERSHED PROTECTION PLAN

Commissioner Emily Lloyd announced that a third public meeting will be convened to discuss the progress of the Jamaica Bay Watershed Protection Plan. In July 2005, Mayor Bloomberg signed Local Law 71 into effect. Its purpose is to create a plan to restore and maintain the water quality and ecological integrity of Jamaica Bay. The law also established the Advisory Committee to advise the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (NYCDEP) and provide recommendations concerning the Plan. In January and February 2006, the NYCDEP and Advisory Committee held two public meetings to provide information to the watershed community about Local Law 71 and the current issues facing Jamaica Bay, and to obtain public scoping comments.

The NYCDEP, along with members of the Advisory Committee, will hold a watershed-wide public outreach meeting June 14, 2006 to provide a status update on the development of the Watershed Protection Plan. The meeting will include visual project information and a presentation by the NYCDEP. The meeting will include time to provide members of the public with the opportunity to make comments and recommendations to the NYCDEP related to potential watershed protection and plan implementation strategies.
